

Cardinal Tracking MobileCite™ | Module Overview

InterActMobileCop provides critical, reliable, real-time text and image data from local, state and national data sources. MobileCite™ is a complete automated citation issuance system enabling police officers to quickly and easily issue any type of citation. Citations can be prepared and issued in as little as one minute, compared with the 10-15 minutes it can take to issue a paper ticket. And electronic citations increase accuracy by more than 10%. Inaccuracy and illegibility in paper-based citations can result in cases being dismissed and in lost revenue.

Police agencies using MobileCop already have secure, immediate access to DMV and criminal justice systems on MDTs in their patrol vehicles. To further enhance the ability of these officers to work more efficiently, speed the issuance of citations and minimize errors and to allow for wireless transmission of citation data to a central server and then into the court system, InterAct has partnered with Cardinal Tracking to integrate MobileCop with MobileCite.

The officer simply scans the violator's drivers license using a mag-card or bar-code reader to quickly populate the query using InterAct's EZ-License software. DMV information is returned to MobileCop for review. This information can be easily transferred into MobileCite, populating the associated data fields in the citation. Completion of the remainder of the citation is made fast and easy by drop down menus and check boxes.

The statute number and fine amount (if desired) is automatically inserted based on the violation chosen. Multiple violations can be issued on a single citation and any combination of actual violations and warnings can be included on a single citation if the agency desires. If another citation is required for an additional violation, MobileCite retains all information from the previous citation and allows the officer to simply select a new violation. The handheld version of MobileCite allows for the capture of digital signatures (officer and defendant) and voice notes. The citation is printed wirelessly to a rugged Zebra printer mounted in the patrol car or motorcycle saddle bag.



Easy data synchronization and open architecture system design allows for interface to any existing court or police records management system, thereby eliminating the need to manually enter citation data into one or more systems- further reducing processing time and increasing accuracy.
